¹⁰ Then Amaziah, the priest of Bethel, sent to King Jeroboam of Israel, saying,

not able to bear all his words. ¹¹ For thus Amos has said,
'Jeroboam shall die by the sword,
and Israel must go into exile away from his land.'"

bread there, and prophesy there; ¹³ but never again prophesy at Bethel, for it is the
king's sanctuary, and it is a temple of the kingdom."
